

## Instructions

This is a test of your ability to organise and prioritise work. You will be presented with information in timetables, charts and tables and will need to respond to a series of questions based on this information. There are a total of 24 questions. For each question you will be presented with five options. Your task is to choose which of these five options is correct. Only **one** of the five options will be correct for each question.

Here are some example questions. These example questions are not timed or scored. They are here to help you to understand how to complete this test.

## Example questions

The table below shows the bus timetable between Heraklion and Kastelli (travel time is approximately 55 minutes)

### Example 1

Which bus from Heraklion will arrive at Kastelli in time for the start of the Thursday market which opens at 8:30am?

### Example 2

Approximately at what time on a weekday does the last bus from Kastelli arrive at Heraklion?

### Example 3

Mrs Kypriou wants to arrive in Heraklion before 11:00 and return home to Kastelli before 4pm on Friday. Which of the following are most appropriate?

A	B	C	D	E
07:00 from Kastelli and 19:00 from Heraklion	07:00 from Kastelli and 15:30 from Heraklion	08:45 from Kastelli and 14:30 from Heraklion	08:45 from Kastelli and 15:30 from Heraklion	09:00 from Kastelli and 14:30 from Heraklion

The answer to example 1 is A: the 06:45 from Heraklion.

The answer to example 2 is D: the bus is scheduled to arrive at 21:05.

The answer to example 3 is C.
