

Game instructions for teachers

The online game “Culture Heritage Detectives” is part of an educational toolkit for teachers, targeting 10-15 year olds. The game can be played in pairs or projected on a white board as a whole-class activity (if you wish to do this, follow instructions available on Lesson Plan 1). To improve research skills, students should be allowed to use the Internet and books available in the classroom to search for answers.

1. Step-by-step instructions

- > The game should be played on desktop. Book a computer room for your class, if need be.
- > Choose language in the language selector – 24 EU languages are available.
- > Follow Marcus’ instructions and select the age group (easy: 10-12 year olds/difficult: 13-15 year olds).
- > Read Marcus’ instructions and click on the play button to continue.
- > Read the question and click on play.
- > Once you read it, a short version of the question will appear next to Markus – if you wish to read again the long version click on the question mark.
- > Click on the correct countries to respond to the question and then click on the tick button to submit your response.
- > Once you submit your answer, please note that you cannot go back to a previous question.
- > If the answer provided is correct, you get a star and you see a short explanation to learn more about this question.
- > Click on play and a new question will pop up.
- > If the answer provided is incorrect, you can play it again or skip the question.
- > At the end of the game, you’ll get to see how many stars you have received.
- > Once you’ve replied to all questions, you can restart the game or go back to the home page.



2. Game tools



Timer

This tool can be adapted to your class' needs; You can use it to set a limited time for your students to play the game (simply tell them to respect an x number of minutes per question – please note timer keeps running and cannot be set to stop a certain time); or you can let it run and ask students to record their overall time spent playing the game at the end.



Stars

Every time students respond to a question correctly, they get a star. At the end of the game, they will learn how many stars they have got.

3. Game settings

The game settings button can be found on the upper right side. It allows you to adjust music and sound. Once students start playing the game, a new game settings button will be available, featuring a short tutorial.
