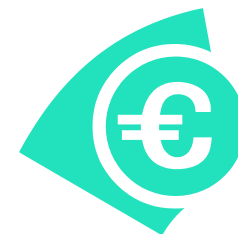

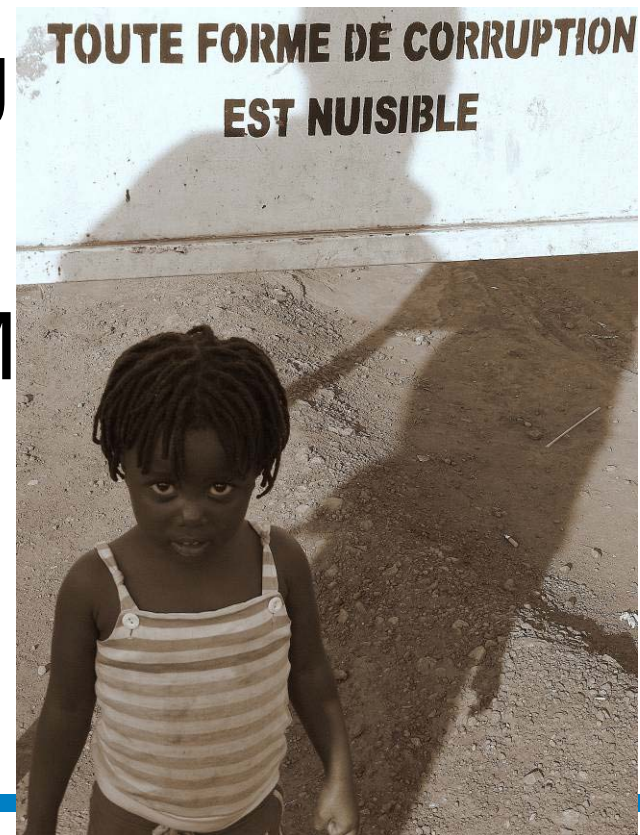




# Support to decentralised agriculture: the case of Rwanda

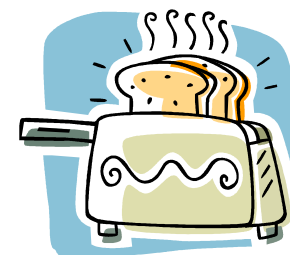
