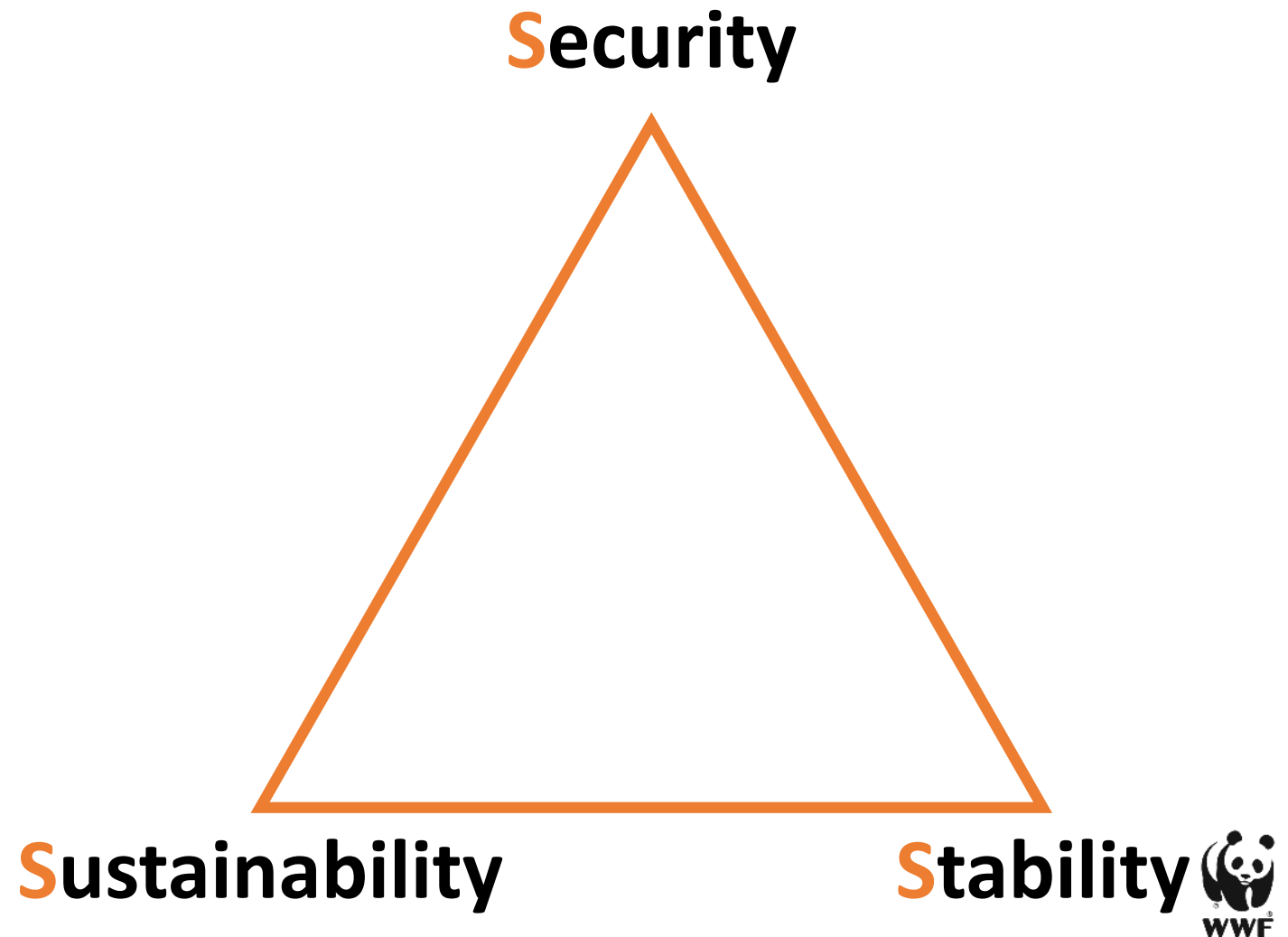

## ***WWF demands for CBD:***

- Zero net loss target in 2030 (*eq of 2°C*)
- Ratcheting mechanism
- Equivalent to NDCs for Nature including national and imported impact





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
