




The Health Financing process




Flexible tool: openIMIS can be used for the main health financing schemes

- National health insurance
 - Tax funded National Health System
 - Community-based health fund
 - Voucher scheme
 - Strategic purchasing arrangements
 - P4P or RBF
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- Create transparency
 - Efficiency
 - Service Utilization and Data




From IMIS to openIMIS

National roll-out: 42 districts out of 77



Nepal


Operational numbers – first application adjustments in 2013, operations since 2016

- 870,000 actively insured members
- 607,286 claims processed
- USD 5,182,000 paid out to facilities
- 6553 total claims received on a single day (e.g. June 11, 2018)
- 3256 Enrolment Assistants using openMIS through Android phones
- 228 Health Facilities submitting claims through web interface
- 5 IT personnel as backstoppers

openIMIS in TANZANIA

Operational numbers – first application adjustments in 2011-12

- 800,000 actively insured members at any point in time
- 1.8 million registered in the database
- 4167 Enrolment Assistants through Android phones
- 867 Health Facilities submitting claims through web interface and phones



Next steps for openIMIS initiative

- Position the openIMIS globally as the digital tool for Health financing and UHC
- Software development – development of new features
- Expanding the network of development partners
- Expanding user countries: RW, MW, CAM
- Expanding the network of implementing partners
 - Support possibilities for country level implementation
- Capacity building: Alliances and strategic partnerships with universities for local capacity building
