Press and Social Media Coverage

The AEEP Second Stakeholder Forum has witnessed among many successes very good press and social media coverage from press and media houses that attended the event as well as the young journalists programme. On Social Media

AEEP Tweets during the past 20 days earned 45.0 K impressions, with a large increase during the days of the forum (16th and 17th of May). This is the largest peak since the AEEP Twitter account was established in 2014. Local journalists and media houses in countries such as South Africa, Gambia and Uganda including BBC Africa were tweeting and retweeting during the event. Some key organizations such as EC, AUC, GIZ, UNHABITAT, Cities Alliance as well as single individuals from the organisations were very engaged live tweeting.
