Objectives

1. To continue to provide the negotiators with a forum to prepare for international negotiating fora to develop joint and coherent regional positions,
2. To provide the political directorate with briefings on the state of the negotiations and the CARICOM positions,
3. Identification and capacity building of CARICOM lead negotiators on the key agenda items in the negotiations,
4. Building development resilience at the local, national and regional levels, and
5. Strengthening local, national and regional implementation capacity.



Priority Programmatic Areas

- **Develop and build capacities in the application and utility of climate impact models, socio-economic assessments and risk assessment and management**
- **Annually host/support meetings of the Caribbean Climate Modellers' Consortium and representatives of key sectors/Lead Executing Agencies**
- **Continue to scale up and replicate Adaptation and Mitigation Initiatives throughout the Region**



Priority Programmatic Areas

- **Support the region in the preparation for Ministerials and International Negotiation Meetings (COPs)**
- **Continue providing guidance to CARICOM Countries in reporting on their National Communications**
- **Continue to conduct Climate modelling for the Region and Nationally**
- **Promoting the use of the VCA methodology for Vulnerability and Capacity Assessments**



Priority Programmatic Areas

- **Scope and develop of a Regional Integrated Coastal Zone Management System**
- **Determine the climate data requirements for impact studies under the 1.5 vs. 2 vs. 2.5 global temperature increase initiative and activities**
- **To produce draft/outline of article under the 1.5 vs. 2 vs. 2.5 degree global warming initiative including a timeline for completion: *Health, Energy, Water, Agriculture Vulnerability; Economics***
- ***Work with CBOs, NGOs and Local Government to build climate resilience***
