NATIONALLY DETERMINED CONTRIBUTION

Paris Package: 1/CP.21

NDCs is a key innovation of Paris Agreement

Para 27 of 1/CP.21 is good starting point of guidelines of NDCs

Operationalize of Capacity Building Initiative for Transparency by Marrakech

ADAPTATION COMMUNICATION

PA: Art. 7 Para 10 & 11

Should **reaffirm SIDS priorities, implementation and support needs**, also provide **flexibility**

NO additional burden

Should address **scope, frequency** and **level of detail of reporting**

Should inform **GST information and data on adaptation support**

Should ensure **consistency irrespective of the vehicle** used

Adaptation registry **should be separate** from the Mitigation registry

Should **fit the unique circumstances** of SIDS

ENHANCED TRANSPARENCY FRAMEWORK

PA: Art. 13 Para 5 & 6

Equal footing for both Transparency of Action and Support in the new framework

ETF should **built on collective experiences and existing work** of UNFCCC

Deliver information to track the process of NDC Implementation

ETC should be **facilitative, non-intrusive, non-punitive manner respectful to national sovereignty** and **avoid undue burden** to countries

MPGs of ETF should have **flexibility for developing countries with respective to scope and level of detail of reporting**

Specific challenges of SIDS needs to be taken into consideration

Operationalize of CBIT by Marrakech

GLOBAL STOCKTAKE

PA: Art. 14

GST should be undertaken according to Art 14 of PA, particularly **comprehensive facilitative manner**

Data quality is important to monitor the progress

Assess **progress of Art 2.1 (a)** of PA

Assess **progress on building resilience** to climate change

Regional perspective needs to be reflected

Adequate resource provided to meet adaptation and mitigation actions

CAPACITY BUILDING

Paris Package: Decision 1/CP.21 Para 71

ToR for the PCCB established in 1/CP.21 will be **discussed at COP22**

Focus area or themes includes

- Capacity for **developing countries to undertake domestic climate actions**
- Capacity to **develop project proposals** for Funds
- Capacity to **assess Vulnerability Assessments**
- Capacity to **assess Loss and Damage**

LOSS AND DAMAGE

AOSIS requested COP22 President to undertake WIM Review consultations in May 2016

Scope and review should focus on **the structure, mandate and effectiveness of the Mechanism as per 2/CP.19**

Review the **completed, ongoing and gaps of WIM and recommendations**

Inputs from **Doha to Warsaw to Lima and Paris** needs to be taken care

FINANCING

AOSIS considers that the accounting modalities should provide a uniform methodology for tracking finance flows from developed to developing countries on the basis of an agreed definition of what counts.

In line with the distinction between finance provided versus finance mobilized to developing countries, establishing agreed modalities to address these categories separately is critical.
