CONCORDIA – Facts and Figures

- Where: Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (FYROM)
- When: 31 Mar – 15 Dec 2003
- Mandate: Contribute further to a stable and secure environment, to allow the FYROM government to implement the Ohrid Framework Agreement
- C2: EU OHQ at SHAPE, FHQ in Skopje
- Strength: ~150
- First EU military operation; Berlin +, follow-up to NATO operation Allied Harmony
- EU Special Representative (FYROM) in place

ARTEMIS – Facts and Figures

- Where: Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC)
- When: 12 Jun – 01 Sep 2003
- Mandate: Contribute to the stabilisation of the security and humanitarian situation in Bunia
- C2: EU OHQ in Paris, FHQ in Entebbe (Uganda) and FHQ Forward in Bunia
- Strength: 2,000
- First autonomous EU military operation, upon request from UN, in order to allow UNSG to reinforce MONUC's presence in Bunia
- France as framework nation
- EU Special Representative (African Great Lakes Region) in place

EUFOR RD CONGO – Facts and Figures

- Where: Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and Gabon
- When: 12 Jun – 30 Nov 2006
- Mandate: Assist MONUC during the electoral process
- C2: EU OHQ in Potsdam, FHQ in Kinshasa
- Strength: 2,500
- Upon invitation by UN
- EU Special Representative (African Great Lakes Region) in place; 2 parallel civilian ESDP missions (EUPOL Kinshasa, EUSEC RD Congo)

EUFOR CHAD/RCA – Facts and Figures

- Where: Chad and Central African Republic
- When: 28 Jan 2008 – 14 Mar 2009
- Mandate: Contribute to a safe and secure environment around camps for refugees and internally displaced persons
- C2: EU OHQ at Mont Valérien, FHQ in N'Djamena and FHQ Forward in Abeché
- Strength: 3,700
- Bridging operation; handed over to UN operation MINURCAT
- EU Special Representative (Sudan) in place



Operation ALTHEA



OpCdr : Gen Sir Richard Shirreff (NATO)
FCdr : Maj Gen Dieter HEIDECKER (AT)

- Dec 2004: NATO SFOR → EUFOR
- Initially 7,000 troops: now ~600 troops
- 19 EU Member States, 5 non- EU TCN
- “Berlin +” with Operation HQ at SHAPE
- FHQ in Sarajevo

Main Objectives:

- To support BiH efforts to maintain Safe and Secure Environment
- To contribute to capacity building & training of Armed Forces of BiH.

ATALANTA – Facts and Figures

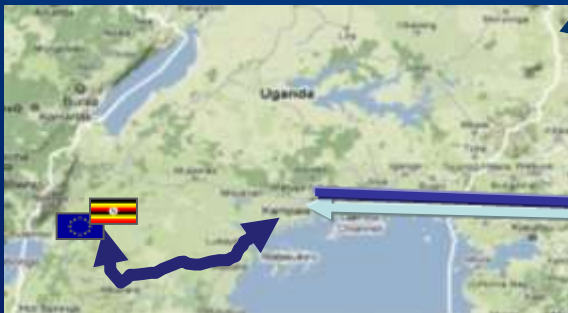
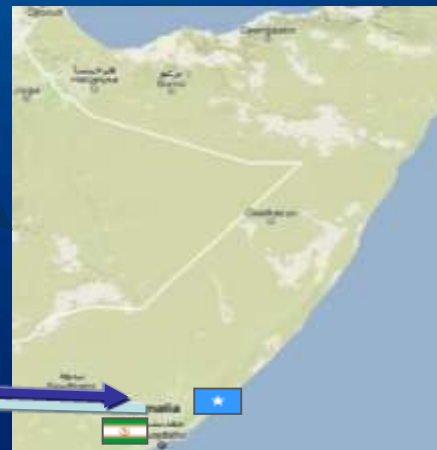
- Where: Gulf of Aden and Indian Ocean off the coast of Somalia
- When: 10 Nov 2008 – ongoing
- Mandate: Protection of vessels of the WFP delivering food to Somalia, protection of vulnerable vessels cruising off the Somali coast, and deterrence, prevention and repression of acts of piracy and armed robbery
- C2: EU OHQ in Northwood, FHQ afloat
- Strength: 1,600 (5/6 ships, 4 MPRA)
- Many other actors: NATO, US-led Coalition, Russia, China, India, Japan etc

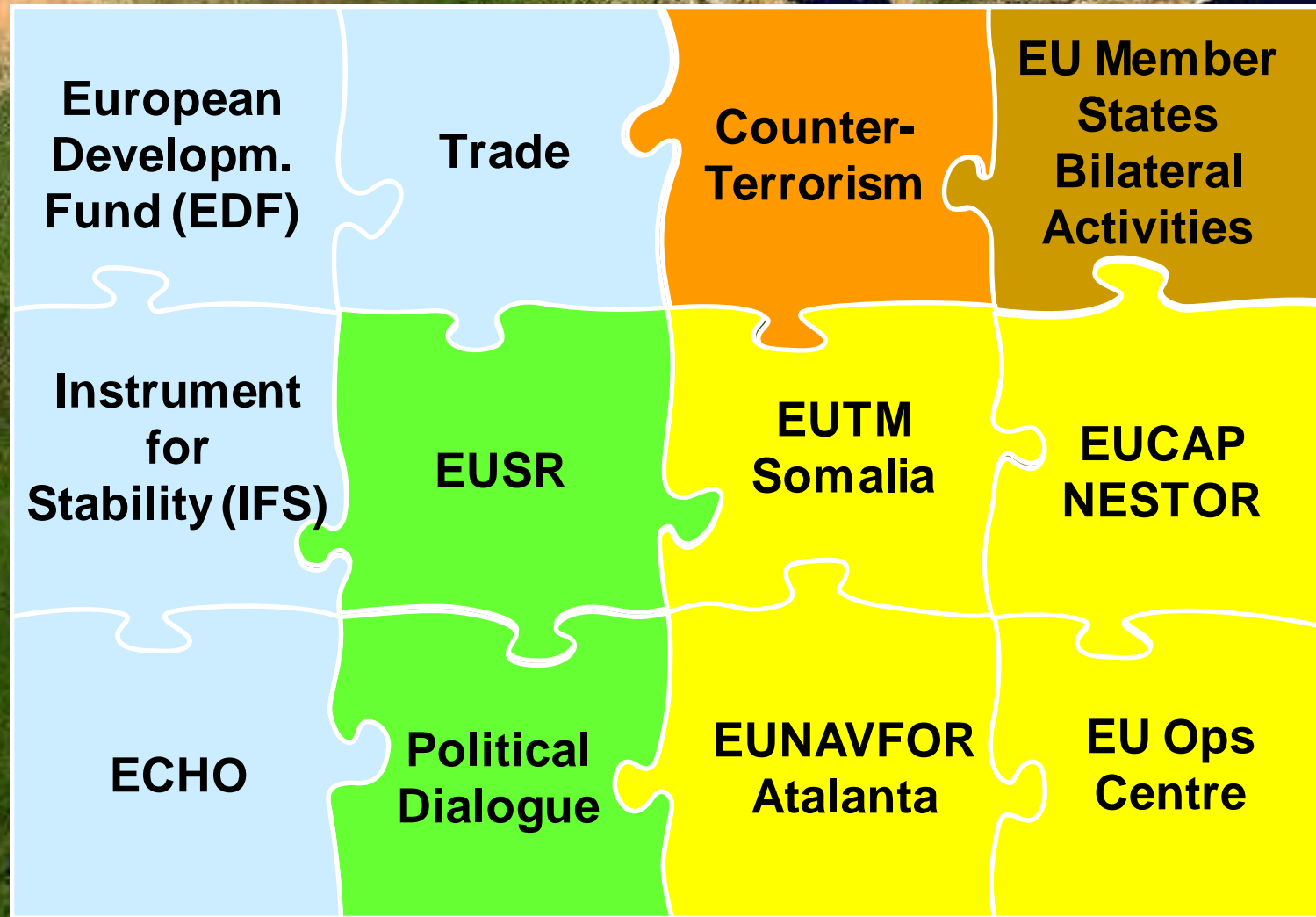

EUTM Somalia – Facts and Figures

- Where: Uganda
- When: Launched on 07 Apr 2010, IOC 28 Apr 2010, FOC 05 May 2010
- Mandate: Contribute to the training of Somali NCOs, Junior Officers and recruits (6 months each)
- C2: EU MHQ in Kampala with support cell in Brussels and liaison office in Nairobi
- Strength: 122
- Joint effort with Uganda, USA, UN, AU, AMISOM, Gvt of Somalia
