From 1990-2008, EU consumption of agricultural commodities and timber resulted in the destruction of an area of forest equivalent to the size of Ireland (nine million hectares.) In June 2013 the European Parliament and Member States agreed to assess the environmental impact of the food and commodities consumed in the EU and to develop policy proposals, including potentially an EU action plan on deforestation and forest degradation. **This conference is being organised to help develop this EU action plan.**
