Call FP7-AFRICA-2010 Background

- **EU & African Union Summit** held in Lisbon in 2007
- Joint Strategy and **Action Plan** adopted
- A joint statement was approved for the Implementation of a Scientific partnership through 19 “**Lighthouse projects**”
- A list of “**Early Deliverables**” to be implemented as priorities
- Two of them were about “**Water and Food Security in Africa**” and “**Better Health for Africa**”



Call FP7-AFRICA-2010

Basic features

- **A Cross-thematic call** on “Water, Food Security & Health in Africa” involving **3 Thematic directorates** in DG RTD, i.e. **KBBE, ENV, HEALTH + International Cooperation**
- The **Africa Call** published **15 topics** drafted in coordination between the involved RTD Directorates
- **Total Call budget: 63 M€**

Theme HEALTH	39,0 M€	(6 topics)
Theme ENV	17.5 M€	(5 topics)
Theme KBBE	6.5 M€	(4 topics)
