The Adriatic-Ionian Euroregion is a network of local and regional authorities coming from the Adriatic-Ionian macro-area, including 18 entities with membership. AIE amis at fostering and co-ordinating from a regional and local point of view the main common development priorities in the A-I macroarea. AIE is engaged to support actively the EUSAIR strategy implementation, in order to bring to the EUSAIR the voice of the LRAs and to give to it an adequate territorial dimension.

The AIE plenary held in Milan on the 21st of September aimed at illustrating to the members the main priorities of the Milan Charter and the objectives of the EXPO 2015; to present, discuss, and approve a common political position of the AIE local and regional authorities on those leading themes; to subscribe together as a network the Milan Charter.
