Title	Can taxes help protect the environment?
Brief description	The activity aims at helping students understand what environmental taxes are and how they support the protection of the environment.
Details	<p>Purpose:</p> <p>Students should understand what environmental taxes are and how they support the protection of the environment.</p> <p>Objectives:</p> <p>Identify the actions that produce damage to the environment and how they can be prevented.</p> <p>Explain what environmental taxes are.</p> <p>Identify the types of environmental taxes.</p> <p>Materials:</p> <p>Micro-clip “Can taxes help protect the environment?”</p> <p>Interactive whiteboard (or just an LCD projector)</p> <p>Vocabulary:</p> <p>taxes, environment, pollution</p>
How to use this lesson	Activity steps:



	<p>Play the introductory part of the clip. Pause the clip and make sure that the students have understood the plot.</p> <p>Play the section “Taxes created to support the protection of the environment”, identify the sources of pollution, the resulting negative effects and the measures taken by the authorities to reduce the environmental damage.</p> <p>Play the next section, pause the clip and identify the types of environmental taxes presented and how they relate to the previous examples.</p> <p>Wrap up:</p> <p>You can organize a class discussion based on the concepts presented in the micro-clip. The topics addressed may include:</p> <p>Identify the environment pollution sources in your town and their negative impact on the environment. What kind of environmental taxes must be paid for each of these polluting activities?</p> <p>Make a list of measures that need to be taken to reduce or eliminate the damages produced by these activities.</p> <p>You can also use the educational game provided in this section as homework for consolidating the concepts presented in the lesson.</p>
